



## Kepler Certified False Positive Table Delivery Log

Date	Comment
2015-07-16	Initial release of the Kepler false positive table. This table contains an entry for every object in the KOI activity tables that has ever been dispositioned as a false positive. On initial release about 1600 objects are certified as false positives or marked as possible planets by the Kepler False Positive Working Group (FPWG). The remaining objects will be examined for certification in the future. See KSCI-19093 for details.
2015-08-17	Update providing additional certifications based on examination by the Kepler FPWG. These certifications are changes in status of existing objects in the table. No new objects are added.
2016-05-13	Update adding 347 newly examined KOIs, yielding 280 newly certified FPs and FAs. New FPs include 232 large-radius KOIs dispositioned as planet candidates in the current KOI cumulative table. The certified false positive table now contains an entry for every KOI in the KOI cumulative table.
2017-06-12	Update adding 918 newly examined KOIs, yielding 758 newly certified FPs and FAs. This update includes examination of all confirmed planets that were dispositioned as false positive in DR25 (one of which, KOI-1450.01, is certified to be an actual false positive), and examination of all DR25 saturated KOIs.
2019-10-04	Final table delivery, adding 1,419 newly examined KOIs, yielding 978 newly certified FPs, 238 new FAs, 94 new data inconclusives, and 407 new possible planets.
